NATIONAL MEMORIAL FUND COVER SHEET

The MEMORIAL FUND Committee is a Standing Committee of the Marine Corps League Auxiliary. All money (from donations, remembrances or memorials) generated by this FUND is to be used ONLY for needy veterans or their families. Distribution of this FUND will be at the discretion of the Committee.

The MCLA MEMORIAL FUND is similar to the Marine Corps League Foundation. Before this FUND was established, the Auxiliary was unable to financially assist a veteran or his/her family who found themselves in a difficult situation. By developing this FUND, we are attempting to alleviate, in a small way, the burden and stress that unforeseen calamities can create.

When the MEMORIAL FUND receives a donation "in memory of" someone, an acknowledgment is sent to the person donating the money and a tasteful announcement is sent to the family of the honored or deceased.

When a catastrophe or unexpected trouble befalls a family and assistance from the FUND seems worthy, you are asked to notify the Memorial Fund Committee Chairman or National Headquarters. Submit a request on letterhead from your Unit, Department or Detachment on behalf of the veteran or his/her family, stating the particulars or nature of the request.

Since our funds are in constant need of replenishing, your gift, however large or small, in the name of a loved one, perpetuates their memory as well as helping a veteran in need.

The MEMORIAL FUND forms are enclosed in the President's Packet each year. You are urged to make extra copies to have on hand should you choose to make a donation at any time.
